



Disciplinary Commission held on 8th December 2009
Decided on the following:-

1. Roundhouse Ruabon FC for permitting the participation of players whilst they were serving suspensions imposed by NEWFA and for failing to control the conduct of their players. Fined £75.
2. Gareth Edwards of Roundhouse Ruabon FC. For bringing the game into disrepute by using offensive, insulting or abusive language toward the match Referee. Suspended for 4 matches from Sunday 10th January 2010. Fined £40 plus costs.
3. Gareth Hughes of Roundhouse Ruabon FC. For bringing the game into disrepute by refusing to give his name to the match Referee for a misconduct charge. Suspended for 2 matches from Sunday 10th January 2010. Fined £20 plus costs.
4. Mark Thompson of Roundhouse Ruabon FC. For bringing the game into disrepute by playing whilst under suspension imposed by NEWFA. And for giving the match Referee a false name for a misconduct charge. Suspended for 1 match from Sunday 10th January 2010. Fined £20 plus costs.
5. Kevin Baker of Roundhouse Ruabon FC. For bringing the game into disrepute by playing whilst under suspension imposed by NEWFA. And for refusing to give his name to the match Referee for a misconduct charge. Suspended for 1 match from Sunday 10th January 2010. Fined £50 plus costs.
6. Garden Village YFC. For failing to control a supporter who used offensive, insulting or abusive language and encroached on to the playing area. The Club were fined £50.
7. Eddie Morris of The Nags Head FC. For using offensive, insulting or abusive language towards the match Referee after being sent off from the field of play, and refusing to give his name to the Referee following a misconduct charge. Suspended for 4 matches from Sunday 10th January 2010. Fined £40 plus costs.
8. Christopher Brand of Borrass Park Albion YFC. For bringing the game into disrepute by playing whilst under suspension imposed by NEWFA. Suspended for 2 matches from Saturday 9th January 2010. Fined £20 plus costs. He was also ordered to pay outstanding £9 administration fee.
